The positions are associated with a recently acquired large European Research Council grant. In addition to providing ample money for equipment and travel, this grant funds a very large high-performance computing cluster ("super-computer") to carry out numerical simulations in support of theoretical studies of topics such as:

Dynamics of gravitational wave sources, dynamical relaxation processes near massive black holes and close interactions between stars, compact objects and

massive black holes.
